Christian is a native of Austria who came to the United States in 1988, in pursuit of fulfilling his dream of becoming a horse trainer. After working for horse trainers in California and Texas, Christian made a move to Wisconsin to attend and graduate from the University of Wisconsin-River Falls. In 1994 he moved back to Texas to pursue a Master's degree (96) and a Ph.D. degree (98) in Equine Nutrition and Exercise Science.

While at Texas A&M University Christian met his wife Elizabeth, who also holds a master's degree in the same discipline. After going to work for Jack Brainard and Purina Mills for two years the couple made a move to the Pacific Northwest to head up the Equine Sciences program at Oregon State University in 2000. There they started a very successful colt training program and annual colt sale. The program proved very popular among students and the Oregon public who attended the annual sale. In 2008 Christian and Elizabeth began training reining horses on a full time basis and made a move to Colorado.
