FALL HEALTH CLINIC

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 10, 2018

On Wednesday, October 10, 2018, Dr. Jeff S. Kerr will be on the grounds to provide for your horse's preventive health care needs. Routine deworming, vaccinations, dental exams, and general consultation on your horse will be available. Vaccinations are recommended twice a year for your horse's protection. Horses boarding at Appleatchee or spending time there regularly are at a moderate to high risk for contracting contagious respiratory diseases. Because of the nature of respiratory viruses including Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis), the recommended vaccine interval for horses with moderate high exposure is every 6 months. We strongly encourage all horse owners to vaccinate for both Equine Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis this fall. No farm call charge and our popular vaccine rebate program through Zoetis has been extended to include the fall vaccination season and will be available through the end of October. Strangles vaccination is also available if your horse is due for his/her annual booster.

This is also a good time of year to have a dental exam. The primary goal of routine dental work is to maintain the comfort of the horse's mouth when working, to prevent poorly masticated feed from entering the colon where it may form an impaction causing colic, and to enhance feed utilization in the interest of maintaining body condition through the colder months.
