

Alert Sense Notification System

The Chelan County Sheriff's Office utilizes the "Alert Sense Notification System" to supply emergency notifications, alerts and other critical information to government agencies and the general public in times of disasters and emergencies. The Alert Sense Notification System is usually activated by the RiverCom 911 Dispatch Center that serves Chelan and Douglas Counties.

Alert Sense enables subscribers to receive warnings, alerts, and notifications through preferred contact methods, as well as language, special needs, and delivery preferences (text, mobile app, email or voice call). Chelan County Emergency Management also uses social media accounts (Facebook and Twitter) to post alerts, notifications and updates.

Appleatchee Riders Group

Alert Sense can also be used to set up an unlimited number of internal groups to initiate alerts during situations that threaten specific government agencies and facilities, as well as other pre-designated groups, when employee personal safety such as crime/imminent danger, hazardous materials, and the need for immediate evacuation or sheltering is required.

A pre-arranged group, consisting of Appleatchee Riders staff, Board members, horse owners, and evacuation team volunteers, can be activated by RiverCom or Chelan County Emergency Management when the Appleatchee Riders complex at 1130 Circle Street in Wenatchee is threatened by a wildfire emergency and evacuation becomes necessary.
