

# TRAINER GUIDELINES

Updated November 2020

**Trainer defined:** A person receiving remuneration for teaching individuals and/or training horses, either in person or via real time video.

- A. Training of member and non-member owned horses subject to limitations;
  - 1. 3 lessons to a non-member
  - 2. A standard release form liability form must be on file in the office prior to initiation of any form of lessons
  - 3. Online and/or video lessons are limited to members only
- B. Training of member and non-member owned horses
  - 1. Trainers must have legal documentation authorizing trainer's use of any non-member owned horse
  - 2. Limited to 3 non-member owned horses on the premises at any one time. (This does not apply to outside clinicians; more than 3 non-members may be allowed in clinics.)
  - 3. Non-member horses will be stalled in the trainers' stall or a trainer subleased stall in member barns subject to limitations in item "A"1 and 2
  - 4. Trainers will provide the standard release form liability for non-member owned horses stalled in show barns
  - 5. Non-member horses in training will be cared for by the trainer and/or a member that the trainer has made arrangements for care
  - 6. AQHA/APHA lease forms will be used for the purposes of documenting trainer's authority to use any non-member owned horses brought onto the premises
- C. A division head may not be a trainer (effective January 1, 2000)
- D. Trainers (on site and via internet/live video) will provide proof of \$1,000,000 liability insurance naming Appletchee Riders Association as additional insured
- E. Proof of liability insurance must be on file prior to functioning as a trainer

## FEE SCHEDULE

- A. Onsite/in person trainers will pay a monthly fee of \$75 for use of Appletchee facilities
- B. Online/Video trainers will schedule time to use WIFI (Wireless Internet Access) with office and receive necessary passwords. There will be a \$10 arena fee per rider, per lesson
- C. Existing rules regarding the Show Barns and schedule events remain in effect
